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SUMMARY

EMPLOYMENT AND EARNINGS STATISTICS – JANUARY TO JUNE 2010

1. An analysis of employment by sector and industry for the period January to June 2010 is presented in Table 1.0.
2. The average number of formal employees for all sectors was 43609.
3. 68.4% of employees were engaged in the private sector, 20.2% in the government sector and 11.4% in the parastatal sector, (Figure 1.2).
4. Of the total number of formal employees, the tourism and construction industries accounted for the largest share of employees. A total of 9595 employees (22.0%) were employed in the tourism industry, of which 7446 (17.1%) were in the accommodation and food service activities industry. This was followed by construction with 6339 employees, accounting for (14.5%).
5. A summary of average number of employees by Industry, Gender and Local versus Expatriate for the Government and parastatal sectors is shown in Table 1.1. More detailed information is given in Tables 3.4 to 3.7. Disaggregated figures for the private sector are currently not available as Social Security records are not currently tailored to supply this information.
6. An analysis of the figures in the government sector shows that expatriates make up 2.9% of the employees.
7. The highest number of expatriate employees were in Education (107) followed by Health and Social Work with (105) employees).
8. A gender analysis of employees in government shows that 63.9% of the employees are female and of the total 1.8% are expatriates, and 36.1% are male employees and of the total male 4.8% are expatriates
9. An analysis of the figures in the parastatal sector shows that expatriates make up 1.9% of the employees.
10. A gender analysis shows that male employees make up 58.7% of the parastatal sector workforce. Of the total males, expatriates make up 3.1%, whereas expatriate females make up 0.3% of the total 41.3% of female employees.
11. An analysis of average earnings by sector and industry for the period January to June 2010 is presented in Table 2.0.
12. Average earnings of employees were *SR 6020* for the private sector, *SR 6052* for the government sector and *SR 7960* for the parastatal sector.

Fig. 1 Percentage of Formal Employees by Industry, All Sectors - January to June 2010

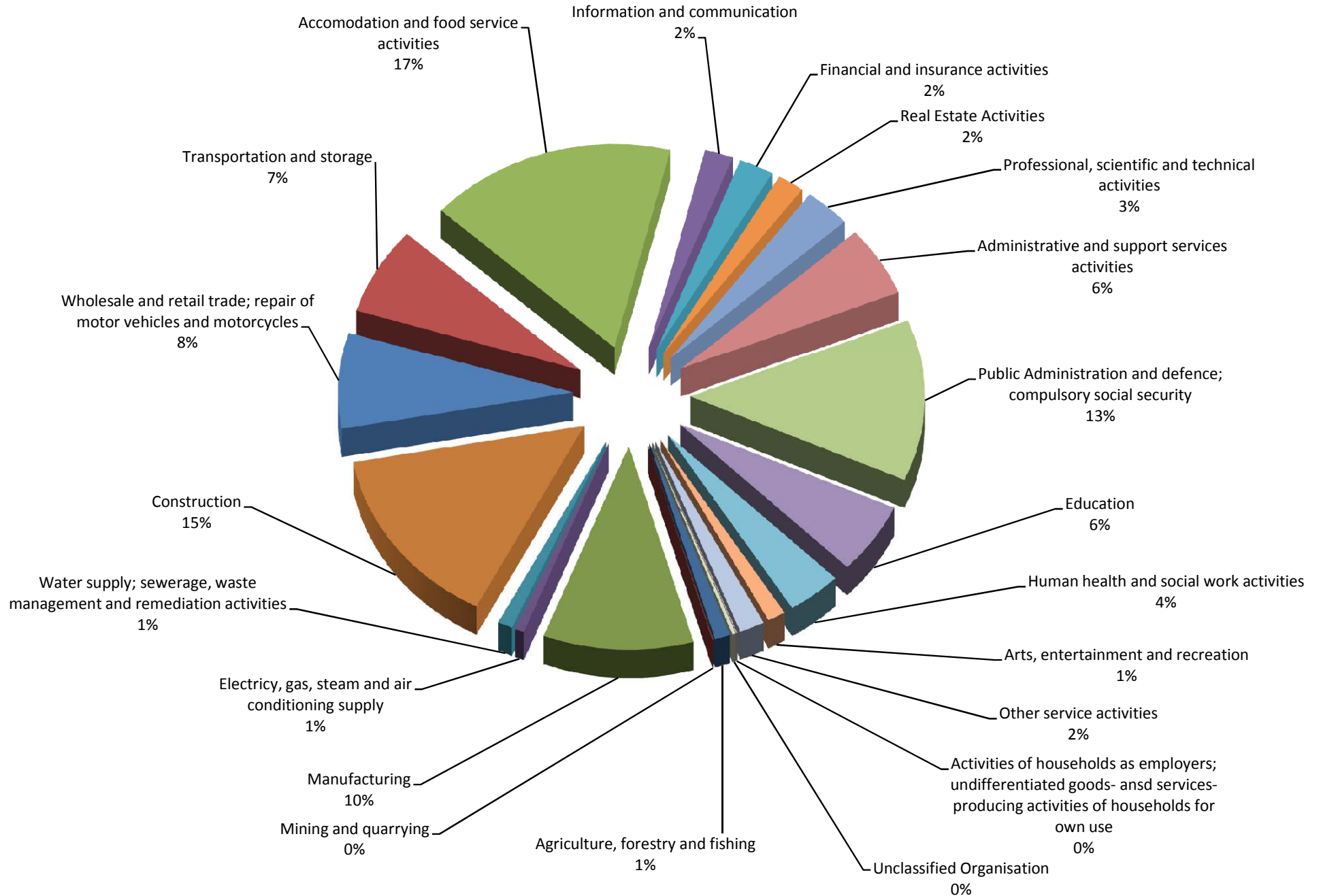


Fig.2 Average Formal Employees by Industry, (All Sectors)
January - June 2010

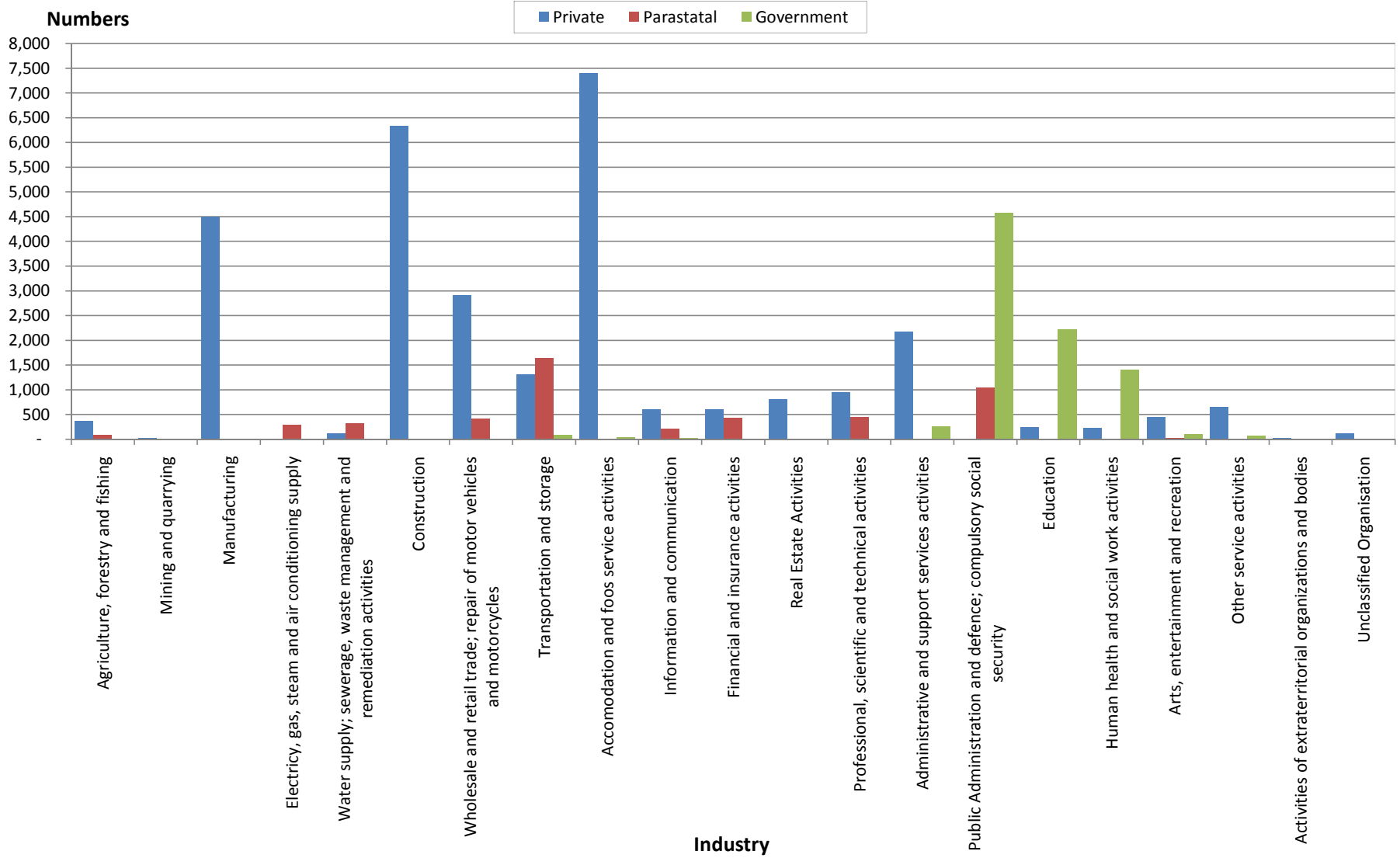
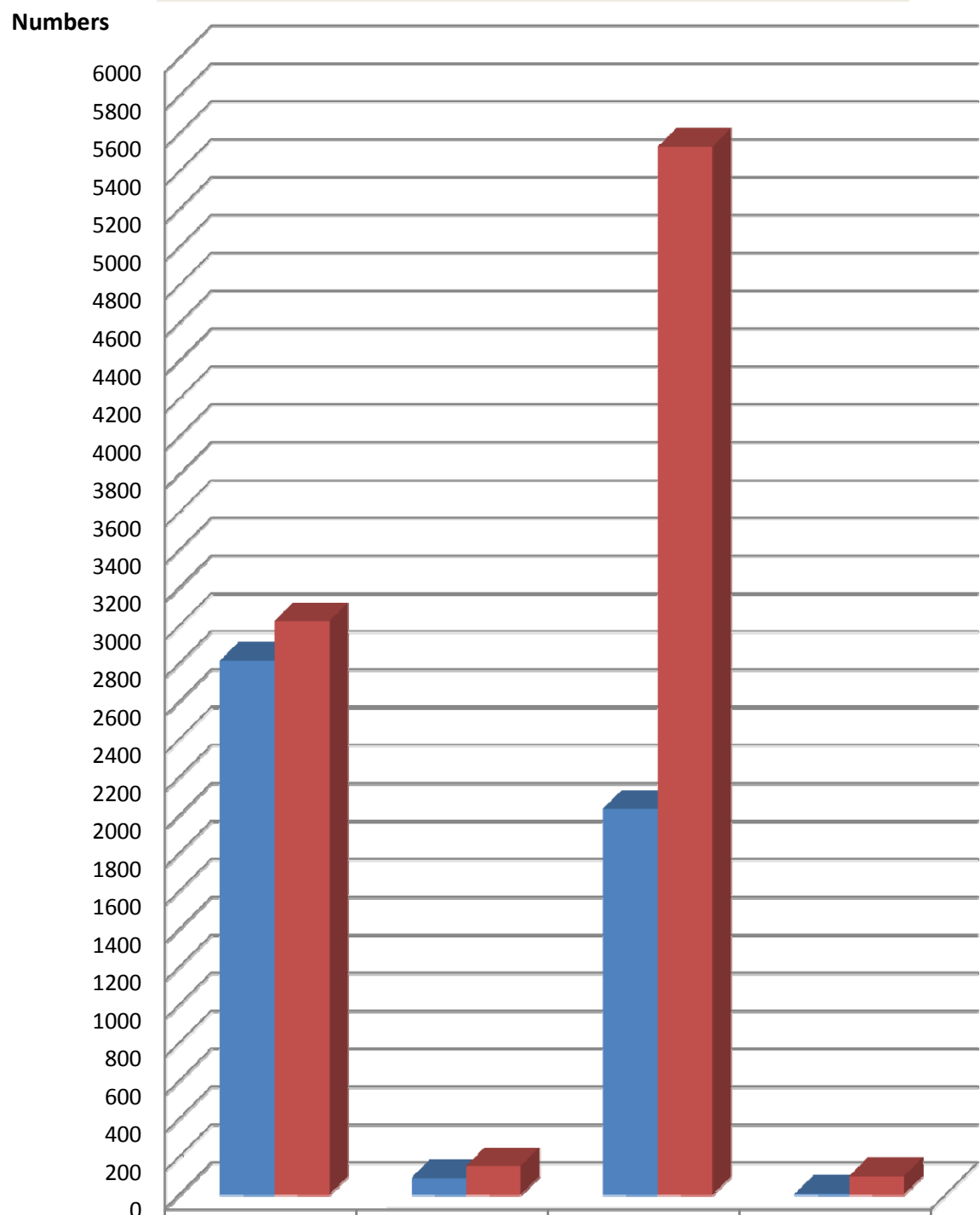
