INTRODUCTION

- Prior to 2009, Industrial Classification of establishments in Seychelles was based on the International Standard Classification of all Economic Activities – Rev.3 (ISIC Rev.3) of the United Nations.
- As from year 2010, the National Statistics Bureau (NSB), found it necessary to adopt the new International Standard Classification of all Economic Activities – Rev.4 (ISIC Rev.4) to meet Seychelles requirements.
- A table showing the changes in the classifications based on NSB's previous classification and the new ISIC Rev.4 is presented below. Note that this refinement however affects only the classification of employment by industrial groups, but not the overall estimate of employment.
- Due to the changes in classification only employment statistics by sector can be compared to previous years. However, yearly statistics by industries for the last 7 year are also presented.

Summary

1. An analysis of employment by sector and industry is presented in Table 1.0 for the period January to March 2010.
2. During the first quarter of 2010, the average number of formal employees for all sectors was 43302. This depicts an increase of 6.0% (or, 2453 more employees) compared to the same period of 2009.
3. During the first quarter of 2010, 68.4% of employees were engaged in the Private Sector, 20.2% in the Government Sector and 11.4% in the Parastatal Sector.
4. Accommodation and foods service activities Industry had the highest number of employees with 7242 accounting for (16.7%) of total formal employment, followed by Construction Industry with 6116 (14.1%) and Public Administration and Defence with 5625 (13.0%).

5. A summary of average number of employees in formal employment for the first quarter of 2010 by Industry, Gender and Local versus Expatriate for the Government and Parastatal Sectors is shown in Table 1.1. More detailed information is given in Tables 3.4 to 3.7. Disaggregated figures for the Private Sector are currently not available as Social Security records are not currently tailored to supply this information.
6. An analysis of the figures reveal that in the Government Sector, expatriates make up 2.8% of the workforce with the highest number employed in Education (105) followed by Health and Social Work with (102) employees.

7. A Gender analysis of employees in the Government Sector shows that of the total Male employees, 4.6% are expatriates and of the Female employees, 1.8% are expatriates.
8. In the Parastatal Sector expatriates make up 1.9% of the workforce, with the highest number employed in the Transport, Storage and Communication industry and making up 1.2% of the total workforce in Parastatal Sector.
9. Of the total Males in the Parastatal Sector, expatriates make up 3.0% whereas expatriate females make up only 0.3% of the total female employees in that Sector.

11. An analysis of average earnings by industry and by sector for the first quarter of 2010 is presented in Table 2.0 below. An increase of 5.1% was recorded in the average earnings for All Sectors. Average earnings for the first quarter of 2010 were SR5957 for the Private Sector, SR5928 for the Government Sector and SR7959 for the Parastatal Sector.

12. The highest average earning for the first quarter of 2010 is found in the Private Sector in the Financial and insurance activities industry showing an average earnings of SR12922. The lowest average earning is found in the Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing industry in the Private Sector showing average earnings of SR3841.

Fig.1 Average Formal Employees for All Sectors - January to March 2010

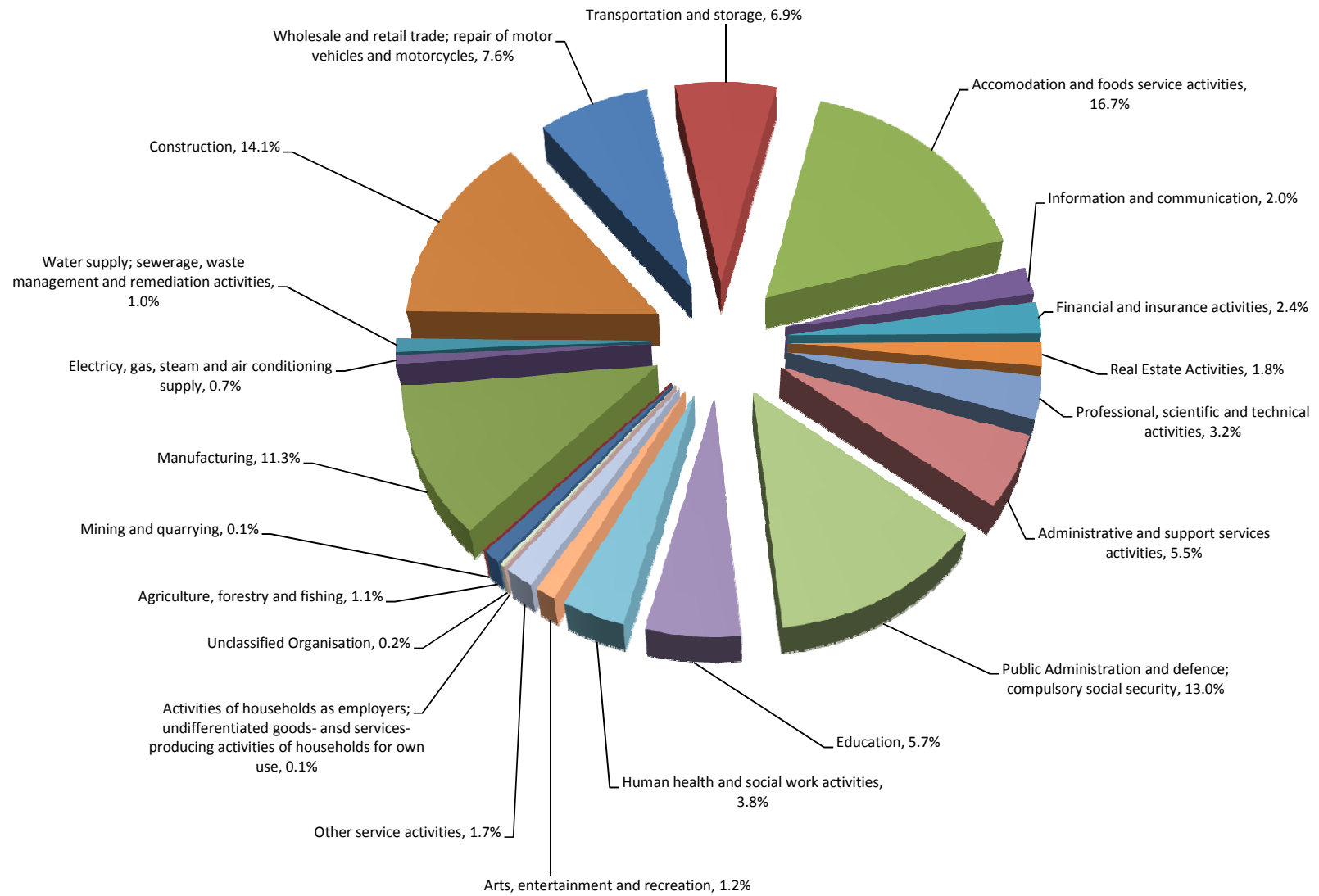


Fig.2 Average Formal Employees by Industry, All Sectors January - March 2010

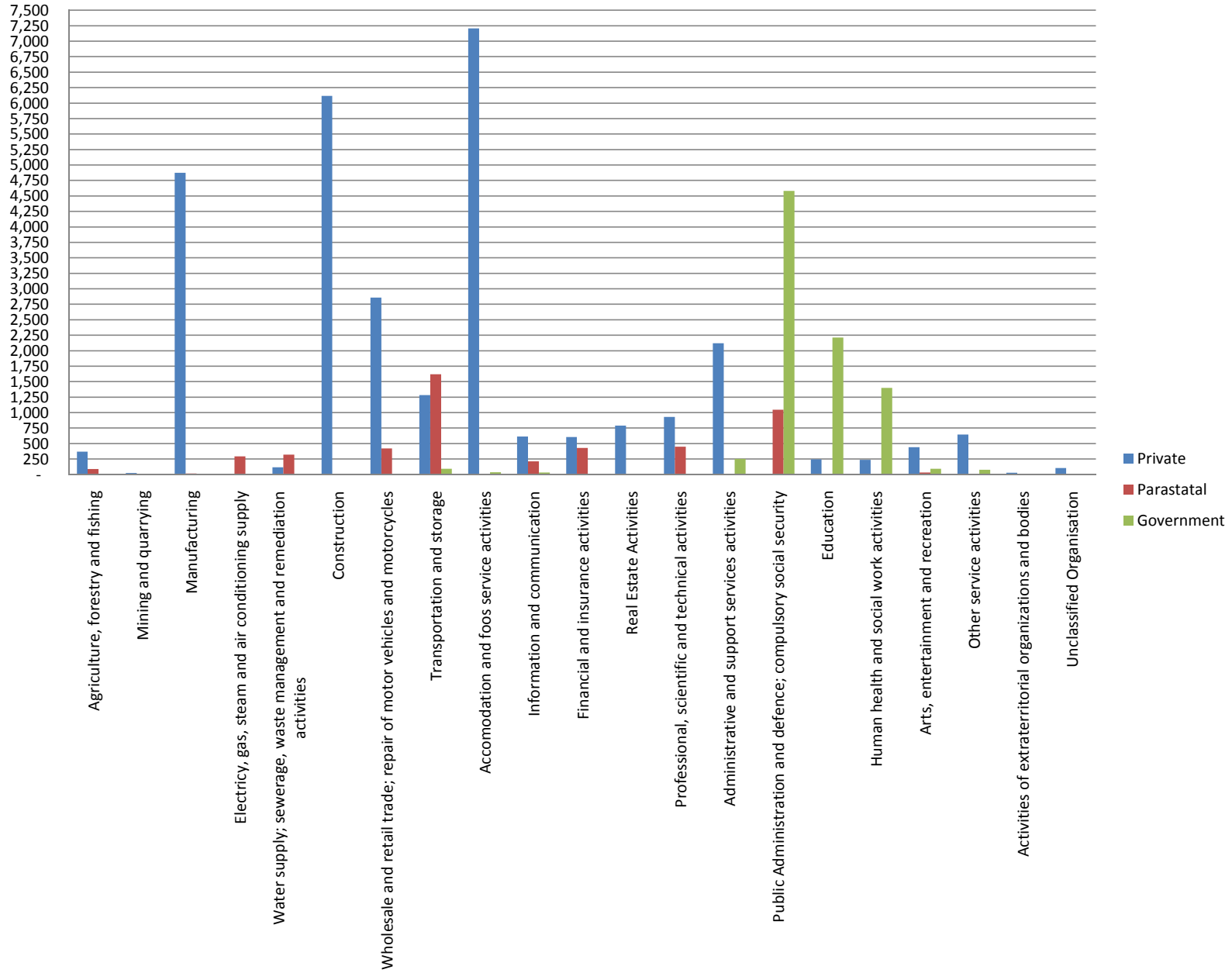
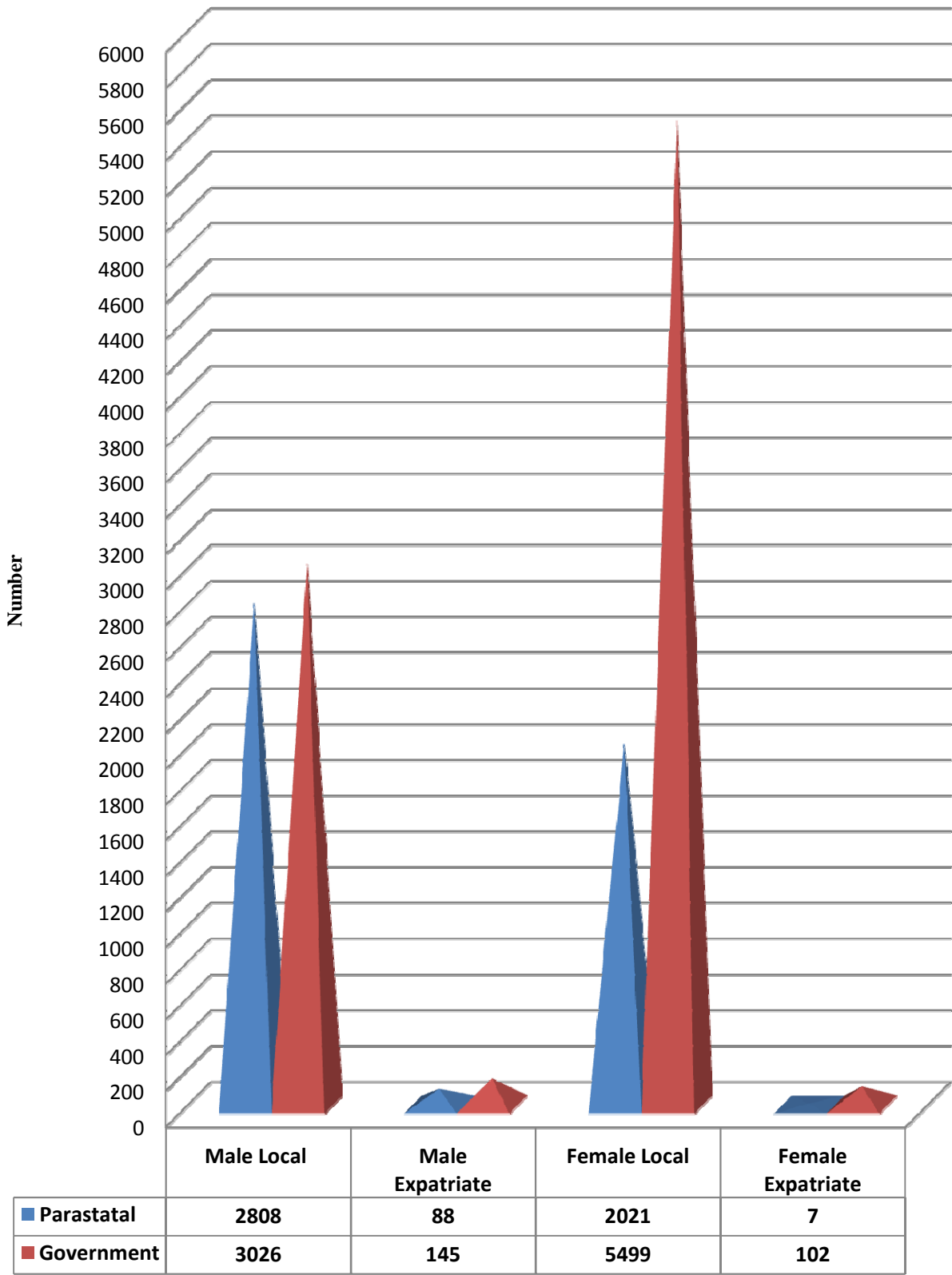
