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POPULATION AND VITAL STATISTICS 2010

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1. Births, Deaths, Migration, 1975-2010
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END OF YEAR POPULATION 2010

1. Table 1 shows the mid-year population estimates, vital events and rates for the period 1971-2010.

POPULATION CHANGE

2. The components of population change for the period 1994-2010 are shown in Table 2. The population is estimated at 84845 persons as at 31st December 2010. This represents a decrease of 2277 persons between January and December 2010 or an annual growth rate of -2.7% over 2009. It is to be noted that over 600 construction workers who entered the country as visitors departed as residents. This had an impact on the magnitude of the net migration figure. If migration is discounted the rate of natural increase (births less deaths) for the same period was 1.7%.

BIRTHS

3. There were 1504 births in 2010 compared to 1580 births in 2009. Of these 740 occurred in the first six months and 764 occurred in the last six months of 2010. The crude birth rate which measures the number of births per thousand mid-year population was 17.4 in 2010 compared to 18.1 in 2009.
4. Table 3 provides information on the number of births by sex and status for the period 2006-2010 whilst Table 4a shows the number of births by birth order and by status and age group of mother for the year 2010 only. Table 4b shows births by district of residence and age group of mother. There are three classes of birth status in Seychelles. Nuptial, Acknowledged and Natural (*see notes*)
5. Of the 1504 births in 2010, 330 (22%) occurred within marriage, 901 (60%) were acknowledged and 273 (18%) were natural. The percentage of nuptial births has increased from 20% in 2009 to 22% in 2010. The percentage of acknowledged births remained at the same level as 2009 (61%). Conversely, natural births decreased from 20% in 2009 to 18% in 2010.
6. Table 4a shows that 207 (14%) of all births in 2010 occurred to women aged less than 20. This has decreased from 16% recorded in 2009.
7. Table 4b shows that the districts with the highest number of births was Anse Aux Pins (93) followed by Anse Boileau (82), Anse Etoile and Beau Vallon with 77 births each.
8. Of the total number of births in each district Takamaka recorded the highest percentage of births to teenagers (29%) followed by Roche Caiman (23%) and Les Mamelles (21%).
9. Table 5 shows the age specific and total fertility rates for the period 1993 to 2010. The total number of children a woman is expected to have during her life has decreased from 2.38 in 2009 to 2.34 in 2010.

DEATHS

10. There were 664 deaths registered in 2010 of which 17 occurred to non-residents (Table 2). The crude death rate for the year was 7.7 per thousand mid-year population. (The number of deaths in Table 1 differs from that in Table 2 because deaths of persons who are not on the National Population Database are excluded from the calculation of the Population estimates). Had the 17 deaths to non-residents been excluded then the crude death rate would decrease to 7.5. Table 6 provides details on age and sex specific mortality rates for the period 2006-2010.
11. The total number of infant deaths (death to babies aged less than one year) for 2010 was 21. The infant mortality rate is 14.0 per thousand live births compared to 10.8 in 2009.

12. Table 8 shows life expectancy at birth by sex for the years 1980-2010. The number of years a male is expected to live is 69.1 years and that for female is 77.5 years.

MIGRATION

13. The net migration figure of (-3134) persons for 2010 was composed of 2603 males and 531 females (Table 9).

MARRIAGES AND DIVORCES

14. There were 1440 marriages registered in 2010 of which 459 were by residents. There were 156 divorces registered in 2010 (Table 10a). Tables 10b and 10c show marriages by age of bride and groom for residents and visitors and for residents only. Tables 11a and 11b show marriages by age and previous marital status of bride and groom respectively for residents only.

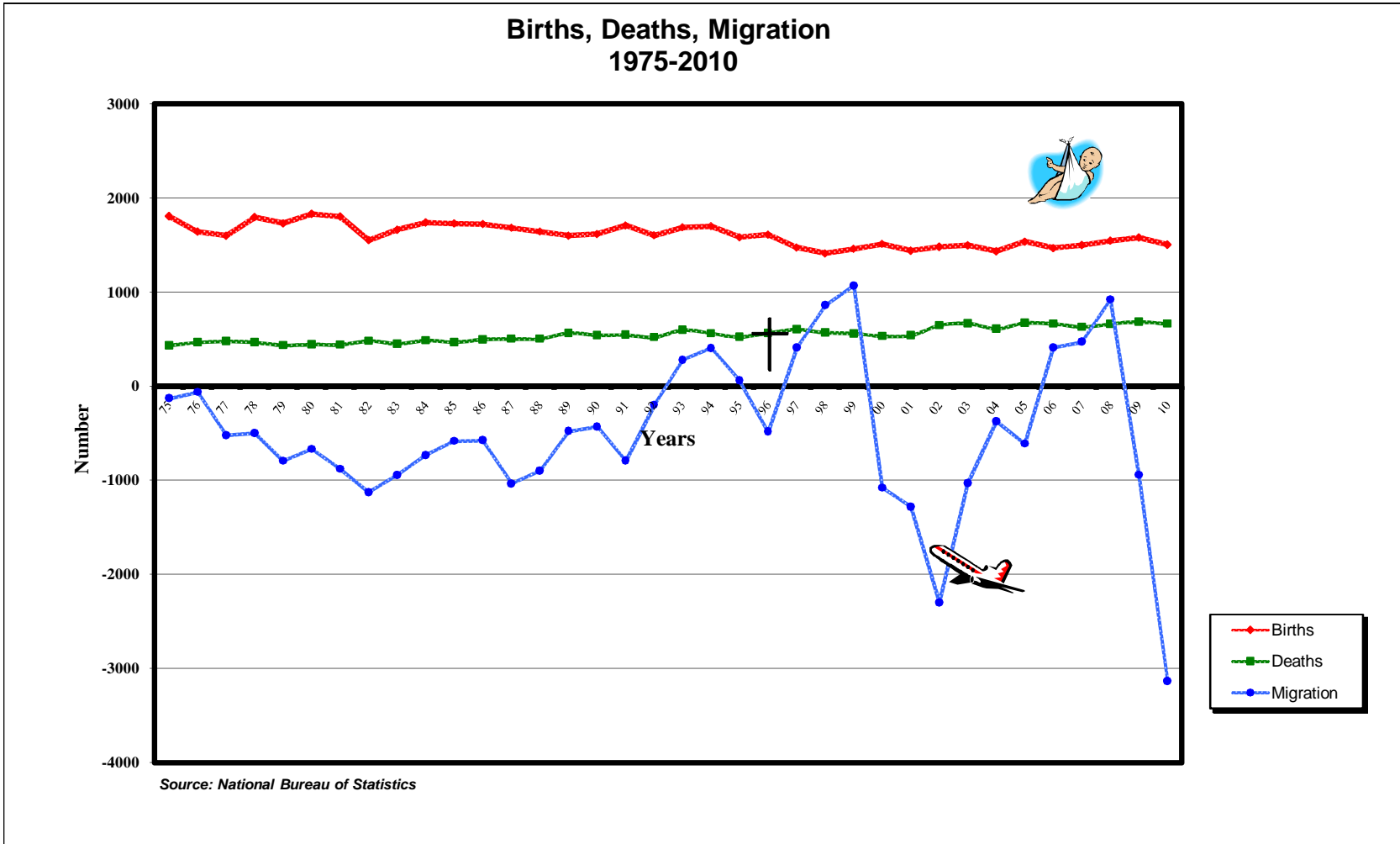

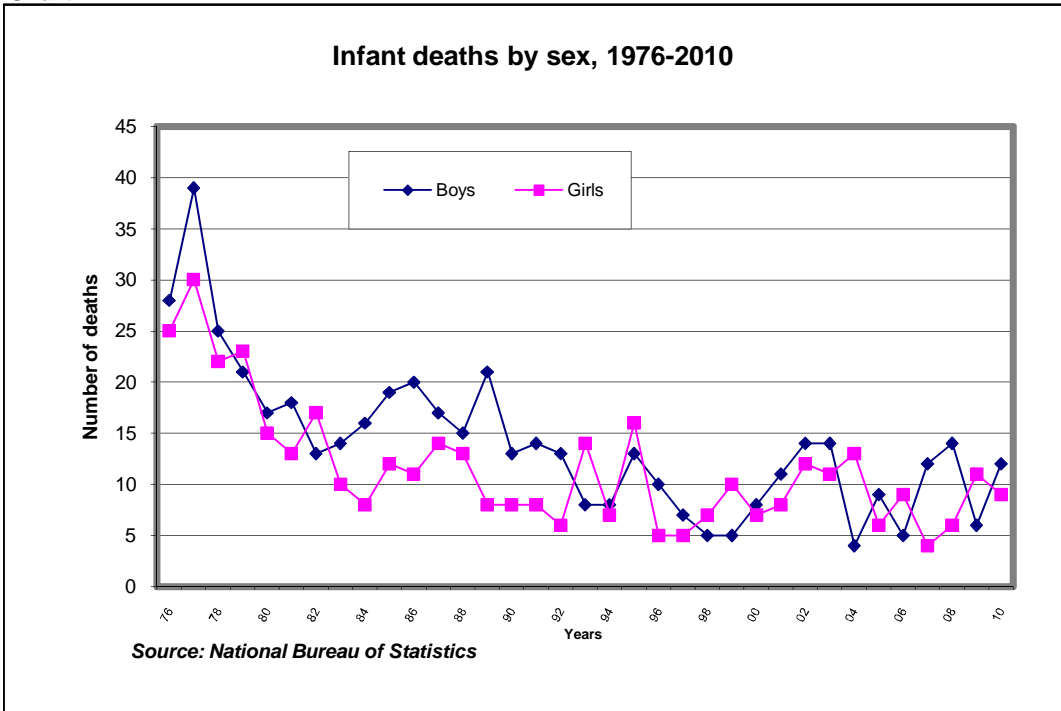

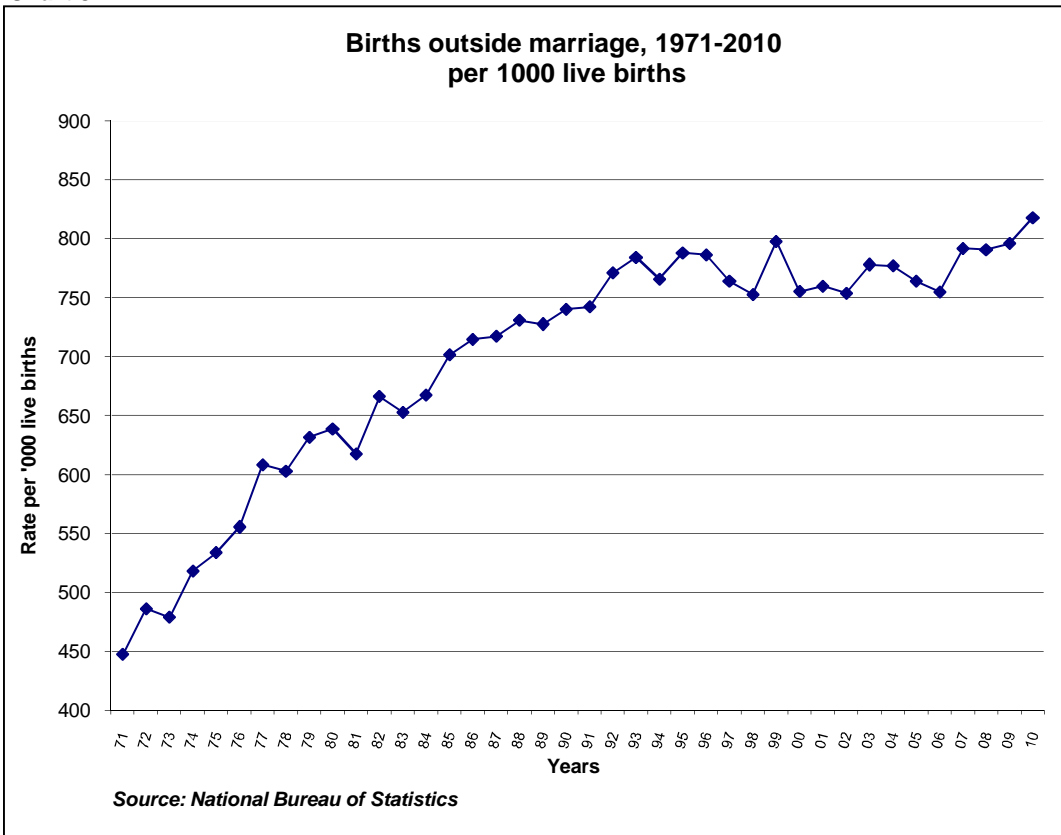
