VISITOR ARRIVALS - WEEKLY BULLETIN (27/13) Week ending Sunday 7th July 2013

TOTAL NUMBER OF VISITORS

Three thousand seven hundred and sixty two (3,762) visitors arrived in Seychelles during the week ending Sunday 7th July 2013.

<u>VISITOR ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE</u> (TABLE 1)

Year to date

The year to date figure for 2013 shows that 116,271 visitors arrived in Seychelles. This figure was 13% above the 2012 figure (102,680).

Overall visitor arrivals from Europe increased by 11% compared to the same period in 2012. An analysis of arrivals by country of residence shows significant increases in visitors from the main European markets. There were increases in visitors from France (15%), UK & Eire (14%), Germany (28%) and Russia (5%). A decrease was recorded in visitors from Italy (-6%).

Visitors from Africa increased by 11% in 2013 compared to the same period in 2012. An increase of 11% was recorded in the number of visitors from South Africa.

Asia recorded a 26% increase in visitor arrivals, with United Arab Emirates and China recording increases of 16% and 58% respectively above the same period of 2012.

Visitors from America increased by 8% whereas from Oceania, an increase of 15% was recorded in the visitors arriving in 2013 compared to the same period in 2012.

VISITOR ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT (TABLE 2)

Year to date

The number of holidaymakers visiting Seychelles in 2013 was 14% above the 2012 level. The number of visitors on business or combining business with a holiday was 21% above the 2012 level and the number in transit was 15% below the 2012 level.
