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### PRODUCTION INDICATORS

An 83% increase in fish catch was recorded in quarter 4 of 2013 compared to the same quarter in 2012. Production of smoked fish also increased by 47% in the fourth quarter of 2013 compared to the same quarter in 2012, whereas the production of canned tuna increased by 5%.

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## 1. SUMMARY

This bulletin presents a set of production figures for some of the most important manufactured items and services produced. Table 1 compares production between quarter 4 of 2013 and that of the same period of 2012, whereas Tables 2 to 6 give annual figures for the years 2010-2013 and quarterly figures for 2012-2013. Graphical representations of selected products are also shown in Charts 1 to 9.

## 2. SOURCES

The source of data in this publication are from the respective manufacturers and producers of the goods and services. The data is collected on a quarterly basis with monthly disaggregation.

## 3. HIGHLIGHTS (2013 / 2012)

### (a) Production of Goods

Comparing 2013 to 2012, an increase was recorded in fish catch (65%), production of smoked fish (48%), canned tuna (17%), spirits (26%) and mineral water (23%). However, there was a drop in the production of beer (-6%), stout (-9%) soft drinks (-13%) and cigarettes (-6%). Egg production also dropped, (-7%) in 2013 compared to 2012. Whilst the production of building blocks dropped, (-9%), the production of paint and paint products increased by 12%.

### (b) Production of Services

Compared to 2012, there was an increase in 2013 in the production of electricity (3%), water consumption (7%), local call hours (8%) and mobile accounts (8%). However, international call hours recorded a drop, (-9%).

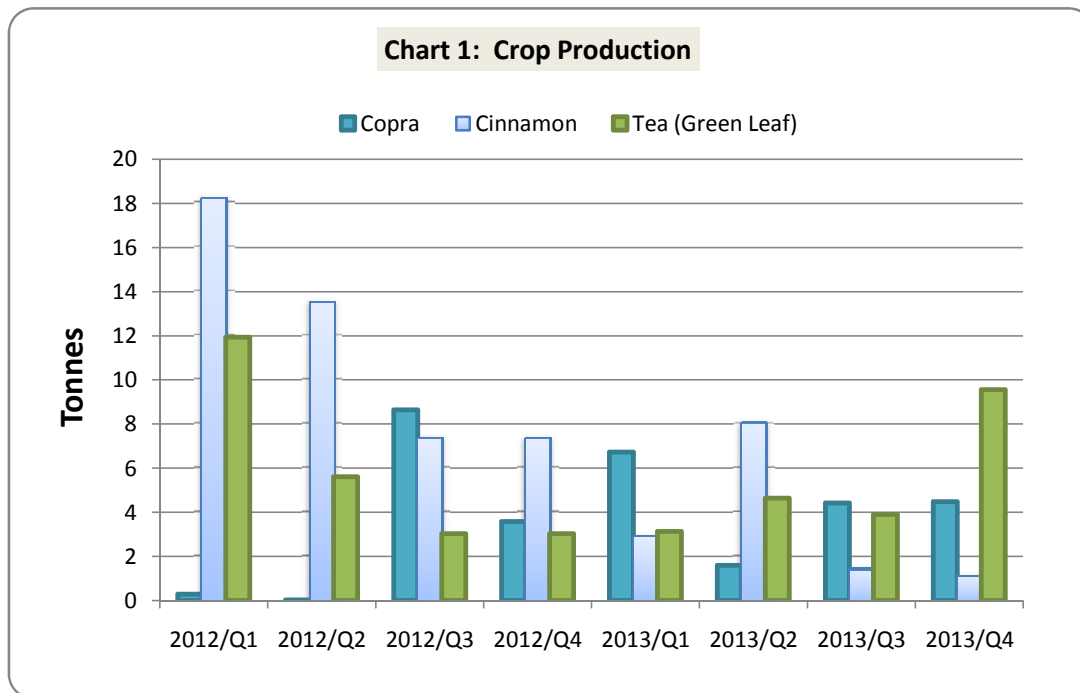

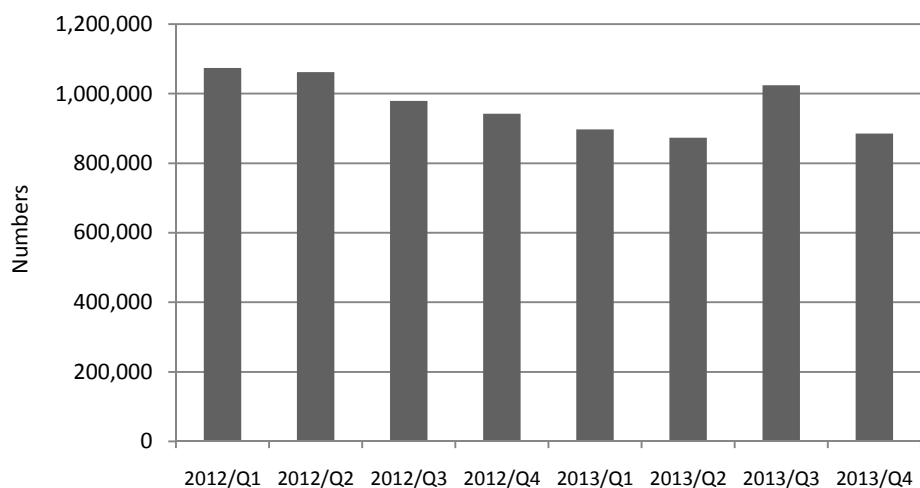

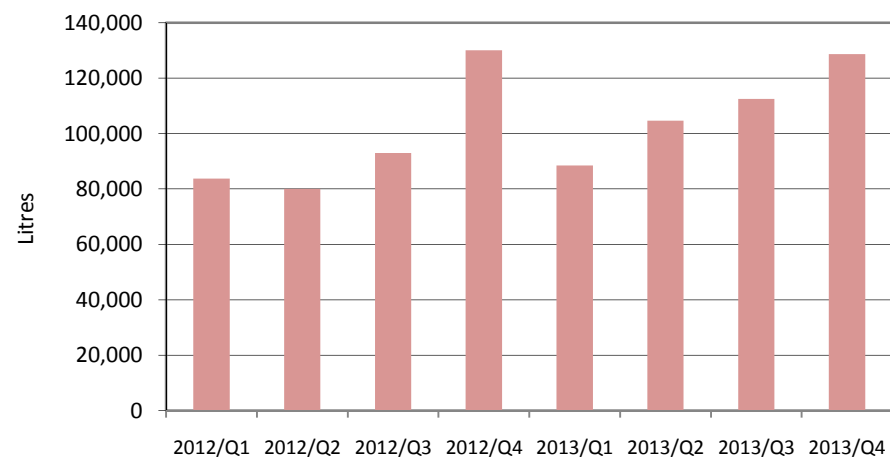
