FORMAL EMPLOYMENT AND EARNINGS

Quarter 2 - 2014

The average number of employed persons for all sectors was **47,256** in quarter two of 2014. This represents a decrease of 0.8% compared to the previous quarter. The average monthly earnings for all sectors was **SR 10,063** representing an increase of 1.9% over the previous quarter.

1. INTRODUCTION

This bulletin presents a series of quarterly formal employment and earnings figures for 2013 up to quarter two of 2014. The objective of this bulletin is to provide a permanent platform to obtain quarterly formal employment and earnings to measure progress in Seychelles.

The formal employment and earnings statistics is compiled according to international classifications based on the United Nations International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC) of All Economic Activities Rev4.

2. RESULTS AND HIGHLIGHTS

The average number of employed persons for all sectors was 47,256 in quarter two of 2014, a decrease of 0.8% from the previous quarter. However, comparing quarter 2 with the same quarter in 2013, this represents a 3.0 % increase in employment.

The drivers of the decrease in employment numbers in 2014 quarter two were Arts, entertainment and recreation, and Construction activities. They reported the highest decrease compared to the last quarter.

The number of employed persons in private tourism related industries was (10,769), whereas in the parastatal and government sectors, it was (778). Altogether employment in tourism related industries accounted for 24.4% of total employment in quarter two of 2014, out of which, 8,836 or 18.7% were in the

Accommodation and food service activities industry.

The table below shows the distribution of employment by sector for quarter two of 2014. Compared to the last quarter, the greatest increase was in the government sector (2.0%). Of the total persons in formal employment 69.1% were engaged in the private sector, 11.5% in the parastatal sector and 19.4% in the government sector.

A gender analysis of the workforce in both the government and parastatal sectors is given in the Table below. Similar information for the private sector is currently not available as the source data for this sector is not disaggregated by sex and local/expatriate groups.

The table above shows that expatriates make up 3.5% of employed persons in government, whereas in the parastatal sector, they account for 7.2%.

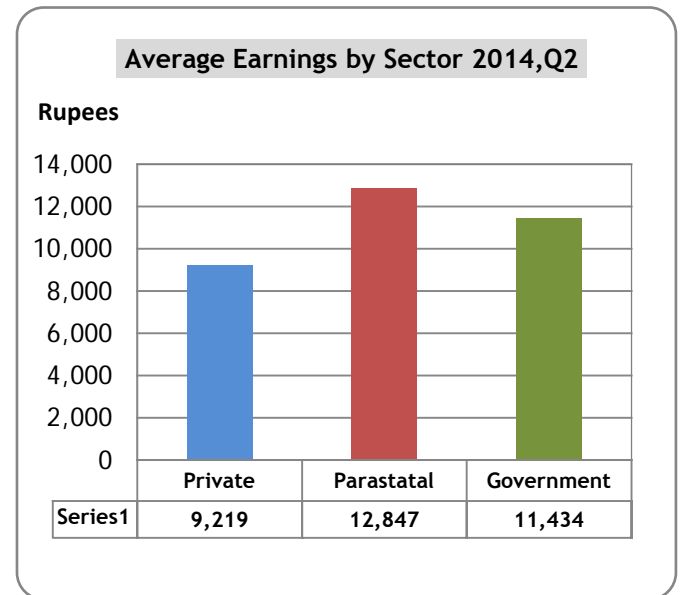
A gender analysis of the workforce in both the government and parastatal sectors shows that while in the former 66.7% are females, in the latter (parastatal) the majority (61.0%) are males.

In the parastatal sector, expatriates are mainly employed in the Administrative and support services activities, Transportation and storage whilst in the government sector; they are mainly in Human health and social work activities and Education.

Average employment and average earnings by industry and sector for 2014 Q2 are presented in Tables 2.0 and 3.0 respectively.

The average earnings for all sectors was SR 10,063 in 2014 quarter two. This represents a 1.9% increase over the previous quarter.

Average earnings were highest in the parastatal sector (SR 12,847) and lowest in the private sector (SR 9,219). Amongst all the industrial groups the average earnings was higher in the Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply industry in the parastatal sector (SR 16,527). In government, the average earnings for quarter two of 2014 was (SR 11,434).

4. CONCEPTS, SOURCES AND METHODS

Employment statistics provide data on the average number of persons in formal employment and average monthly earnings (gross). These are compiled quarterly by industry (ISIC Rev.4) and sector (private, parastatal, and government).

Employment and earnings data for government and parastatal sectors are published disaggregated by gender (males & females) and by local versus expatriate.

The source of data for formal employment and earnings statistics is mainly from administrative sources. Government and parastatal data are obtained respectively from the payroll register at the Seychelles Treasury Department and the Department of Information, Communication and Technology (DICT), as well as directly from the commercial public sector organizations. Data for the private sector data is obtained from the Seychelles Revenue Commission (SRC).

It is to be noted that the formal employment and earnings figures do not include those of the Seychelles People's Defence Forces (SPDF) as the data for this entity is not provided to the NBS for security reasons.

The formal employment and earnings statistics is compiled quarterly based on monthly data collection. The data is compiled in an excel spreadsheet using excel pivot tables.

In the process of data analysis, less than 2% of the 2014 quarter two data on employment and earnings for the private sector has been amended and imputed.

Any changes in employment and earnings data as a result of updated source data that occur after the data analysis will be reflected in the next quarterly bulletin.
