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### POPULATION AND VITAL STATISTICS

#### MID YEAR POPULATION ESTIMATES 2014

The population of Seychelles stood at 91,359 at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014, indicating a growth rate of 1.6% over 2013. In mid 2014 there were 45,278 males and 46,081 females or an approximate ratio of 983 men for every 1000 women. There were 777 births and 362 deaths registered in the first six months of 2014.

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## MID YEAR POPULATION 2014

### 1. POPULATION CHANGE

The population of Seychelles is estimated at 91,359 persons as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014. This represents an increase of 1,410 persons or an annual growth rate of 1.6% since 1<sup>st</sup> July 2013. Table 1 shows the mid-year population estimates, vital events and rates for the period 1971-2014.

Table 2a shows the components of population change for the period 2002-2014. During the period July 2013 to June 2014 an actual growth rate of 1.6% was recorded while the rate of natural increase (births less deaths) was 2.3%. On a longer time scale, the population increased from 74,205 in 1994 to 91,359 in 2014 with an annual growth rate of 1.5% per annum. If migration is discounted, the rate of natural increase for that same period is 1.0% per annum which is the rate at which the Seychelles population would double in 54 years.

Table 3 presents the mid 2014 population by single years. In 2014 there were 45,278 males and 46,081 females or an approximate ratio of 983 men for every 1000 women. The population pyramid (Figure 2) presents a graphic display of the mid-2014 population.

Table 4 shows the mid-year population estimates by broad age groups for the years 2010-2014. The proportion of persons of prime working age (20-54) has increased from 47.2% in 2010 to 47.6% in 2014 and the proportion aged 55-64 has increased from 6.8% in 2010 to 9.2% during that same period.

Table 5 indicates that the age dependency ratio has continuously declined from 689 in 1990 to 424 in 2014. The age-dependency ratio measures the number of persons in the dependent age (under 15 and 65 years and above) to those in the economically productive age (15-64).

### 2. BIRTHS

Table 6 shows the status of births in Seychelles since 2010. Of the 1,535 births between 1<sup>st</sup> July 2013 and 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014, 758 occurred in the second half of 2013 and 777 occurred in the first half of 2014.

The proportion of nuptial births increased from 21.9% in 2010 to 23.0% in the first six months of 2014. The proportion of acknowledged births (where the baby has been recognised by the father) also increased from 60% in 2010 to 61% whilst the proportion of non-acknowledged births decreased from 18% in 2010 to 16% in the first six months of 2014.

Table 7 shows that 93 or (12%) of all births in the first six months of 2014 occurred to women aged less than 20 years. This has decreased from 15% recorded for the same period of 2013.

Table 8 shows that the districts with the highest number of births for the first six months of 2014 were English River (53), Saint Louis (52), Anse Etoile and Baie Sainte Anne both with (46).

Of the total number of births in each district, Les Mamelles recorded the highest percentage of births to teenagers (23%), followed by La Digue and Pointe Larue with (21%) each.

### 3. DEATHS

There were 729 deaths registered in the period July 2013 to June 2014. Of these deaths, 367 occurred during the last six months of 2013 whilst 362 occurred in the first six months of 2014. (The number of deaths in Table 2 excludes deaths occurring to persons not on the NPD. Those persons are excluded from the calculation of the population estimates).

The total number of infant deaths (death to babies aged less than one year) for the same period was 29. Of these, 18 occurred in the last six months of 2013 and 11 in the first half of 2014.

### 4. MIGRATION

The net migration figure of (561) persons for the period July 2013 to June 2014 (Table2) was made up of 129 male and 432 female in migrants.

## 5. CONCEPTS, SOURCES, METHODS AND DEFINITION

The population estimates refers to the number of persons in the population at 30<sup>th</sup> June each year, and the statistics are referred to as the mid-year estimates. These statistics are produced at the country level, broken down by single year and sex. These estimates refer to the usual resident population which is based on the UN guidelines and are benchmarked to the results of the Population and Housing Census.

Estimates at district level are also available. However, these are not disaggregated by age and sex.

Each year population estimates are updated using a standard technique known as the "cohort component method". The previous year's population estimate is "aged on" by one year, with births added and deaths and net migration subtracted. The base year, births, deaths and migration refers to the period Jul-Dec 2013 and Jan-June 2014. Explanatory notes are given below for each of the Population components.

### BIRTHS

Births figures are obtained from the Civil Status offices for all registered births. Births to non-Seychellois mothers are included.

### DEATHS

Death figures are obtained from the Civil Status office for all registered deaths. Deaths to non-residents and deaths to babies who have not been registered as a birth are excluded in the mid-year estimates calculation.

### MIGRATION

Migration is the geographic movement of people across a specified boundary for the purpose of establishing a new permanent or semi permanent residence. The terms "immigration" and "emigration" are used to refer to moves between countries (international migration).

Data on Migration is collected from embarkation and disembarkation cards at the Immigration

Division. Net Migration is immigrants less emigrants.

## 6. DEMOGRAPHIC DEFINITIONS

**Birth rate:** The birth rate (also called the crude birth rate) indicates the number of live births per 1,000 population in a given year.

**Death rate:** The death rate (also called the crude death rate) indicates the number of deaths per 1,000 population in a given year.

**Infant Mortality rate:** The number of deaths of infants under age 1 per 1,000 live births.

**Growth rate:** The growth rate is the rate at which a population is increasing (or decreasing) in a given year due to

### (a) *natural increase* and (b) *net migration*

It is expressed as a percentage of the base population, and takes into account all components of population growth: **Births, Deaths, and Migration.**

**Doubling time:** Growth expressed as a percentage is not very descriptive for many purposes. Is a 3 percent growth rate fast or slow? A more vivid way of showing population growth is to calculate how long, at its current growth rate, a population would take to double in size.

**Age Dependency ratio:** It is the ratio of people in the "dependent" ages (those under age 15 and ages 65 and older) to those in the "economically productive" ages (15 to 64 years) in a population. The age-dependency ratio is often used as an indicator of the economic burden the productive portion of a population must carry—even though some people defined as "dependent" are producers and some people in the "productive" ages are economically dependent.

## 7. NEXT RELEASE

This bulletin was not released on 18th August as per the Advance Release Calendar due to delays in receiving data from our administrative source. The next release of the population bulletin will be in March 2015.

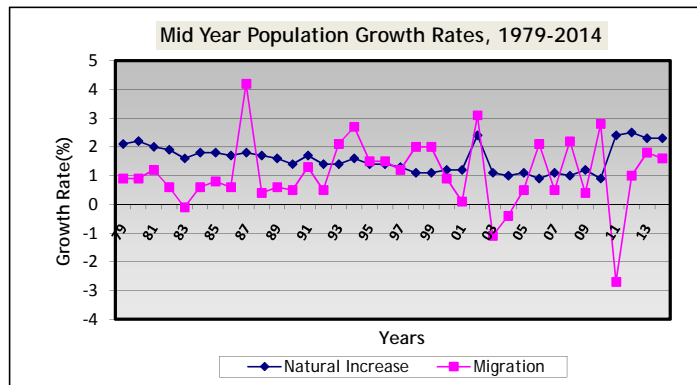
