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PRODUCTION INDICATORS

Quarter 1 - 2015

An increase of 75% was recorded for the production of animal feed for 2015 quarter 1, compared to the same quarter for 2014. Other notable increases were in the production of canned tuna 11%, soft drinks 51% and copra 2235%.

Production of green leaf tea decreased by -45%, as did fish catch by -39%.

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1. SUMMARY

This bulletin presents a set of production figures for some of the most important manufactured items and services produced. Table 1 compares production between quarter 1 of 2015 and that of the same period of 2014, whereas Tables 2 to 6 give annual figures for the years 2011-2014 and quarterly figures for 2013-2015. Graphical representations of selected products are also shown in Charts 1 to 9.

2. HIGHLIGHTS (2015 Q1 / 2014 Q1)

(a) Production of Goods

Comparing 2015 Q1 to 2014 Q1 increases were recorded in paints production (30%) and soft drinks production (51%). Cinnamon production recorded the highest increase of (5094%) followed by copra production (2235%). An augmentation was also recorded in the production of spirits (67%) and soap (69%).

However, there was a drop in the production of green leaf tea (-45%), fish catch (-39%), cigarettes (-1%) and plastering dust (-10%).

The biggest decrease was recorded in the production of layer chicks (-69%) followed by ice cream production (-67%).

Beer and stout also dropped (-28%) in 2015 Q1 compared to 2014 Q1.

(b) Production of Services

There was an increase in 2015 Q1 in the production of electricity (4%), water consumption (2%), international calls (31%), data traffic downloads (25%) and mobile account (11%), compared to 2014 Q1. Telephone exchange lines decreased by (-15%) compared to 2014 Q1.

3. SOURCES

The source of data in this publication are from the respective manufacturers and producers of the goods and services. The data is collected on a quarterly basis with monthly disaggregation.

The next issue of the Bulletin with production numbers for the second quarter of 2015 will be released on Friday 28th August.
