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FORMAL EMPLOYMENT AND EARNINGS

2015 QUARTER 2

In 2015 Q2, the average number of employed persons for all sectors was **48,635** and average earnings were **SR 10,354**. This represents an increase of **2.5%** in employment numbers and **2.6%** in average earnings compared to the same quarter in 2014.

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1. INTRODUCTION

This bulletin presents a series of quarterly formal employment and earnings figures for 2014 to 2015 Q2 and annual figures for 2012-2014.

The formal employment and earnings statistics is compiled according to international classifications based on the United Nations International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC) of All Economic Activities, Rev.4.

2. RESULTS AND HIGHLIGHTS

The average number of employed persons for all sectors was 48,635 in 2015 Q2 compared to 47,403 in 2014 Q2. This represents an increase of 2.5%.

Increases in employment numbers in 2015 Q2 were recorded in the following industries Information and communication (13.9%), Transport and Storage (8.3%), and Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles (8.8%) whereas decreases were recorded in the Construction industry (-4.7%) and Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (-3.4%), compared to same quarter in the previous year.


The number of employed persons in tourism related industries in the private sector stood at (10,956) and employment in tourism related parastatals and government was (793). This represents 24.1% of total employment in 2015 Q2. Of these, 9,105 or 18.7% of total employment were in the accommodation and food service activities industry.

Table A shows the distribution of employment by sector for 2015 Q2. Compared to the same

period in 2014, increases in employment were recorded in the parastatal sector (4.6%) and in the private sector (2.9%). Employment in the Government sector remained flat. The private sector however remains the largest employer with 69.5% of employed persons engaged in this sector followed by government with 18.8% and parastatal sector with 11.6%.

A gender analysis of the workforce in both the government and parastatal sectors is given in Table B. Similar information for the private sector is currently not available as the source data for this sector is not disaggregated by sex and local/expatriate groups.

Table B above shows that expatriates make up 3.9% of the employed persons in government whereas in the parastatal sector, they account for 8.4%.


A gender analysis of the workforce in both the government and parastatal sectors shows that while in the former 65.8% are females, in the latter (parastatal), the majority (60.6%) are males.

In the parastatal sector, expatriates are mainly employed in the Administrative and support services activities and Transportation and storage whilst in the government sector, they are mainly in Human health and social work activities and Education.

Average employment by industry and sector, and average earnings by industry and sector for 2015 Q2 are presented in Tables 2 and 3 respectively.

The average earnings for all sectors were SR 10,354 in 2015 Q2. This represents an increase of 2.6% over the same quarter in 2014.

In 2015 Q2, average earnings were highest in the parastatal sector (SR 13,591) and lowest in the private sector (SR 9,166). Amongst all the industrial groups, the average earnings was higher in the Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply industry in the parastatal sector, (SR 19,079). In government, the average earnings were (SR 12,060).

4. CONCEPTS, SOURCES AND METHODS

Employment statistics provide data on the average number of persons in formal employment, and gross average monthly earnings (SR). These are compiled quarterly by industry (ISIC Rev.4) and sector (Private, Parastatal, and Government).

Employment and earnings data for Government and Parastatal sectors are published disaggregated by gender (males & females) and by local versus expatriate.

The data for the compilation of formal employment and earnings statistics is obtained mainly from administrative sources. Government and Parastatal data are obtained respectively from the payroll register at the Seychelles Treasury Department and the Department of Information, Communication and Technology (DICT), as well as directly from commercial public sector organizations. Data for the private sector data is obtained from the Seychelles Revenue Commission (SRC).

It is to be noted that the formal employment and earnings figures do not contain those of the Seychelles People's Defence Forces (SPDF) as the data for this organization is not provided to the NBS for security reasons.

The formal employment and earnings statistics is compiled quarterly based on monthly data collection. The data is compiled in an excel spreadsheet using excel pivot tables.

In the process of analysis, less than 2% of the 2015 Q2 data on employment and earnings for the private sector has been amended and imputed.

Any changes in employment and earnings data as a result of updated source data that occur after the data analysis will be reflected in the following quarterly bulletin.
