

**WEEKLY VISITOR ARRIVALS**  
**Week ending Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2016**

A total of **6,530** visitors arrived in Seychelles during week 36 of 2016. The year to date figure for 2016 shows that **202,235** visitors disembarked in Seychelles. This was 10% above that of 2015 (184,508).

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This issue of the bulletin presents visitor arrivals for the week ending Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2016. The classification used for this presentation is based on the Recommendations of Tourism Statistics adopted by the World Tourism Organization (UNWTO).

Visitors are classified by their country of residence rather than country of birth / nationality.

## 2. RESULTS AND HIGHLIGHTS

### TOTAL NUMBER OF VISITORS

Six thousand five hundred and thirty (6,530) visitors arrived in Seychelles during the week ending Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2016.

### VISITOR ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE (TABLE 1)

#### Year to date

The year to date figure for 2016 shows that 202,235 visitors arrived in Seychelles. This was 10% above that of 2015 (184,508).

Overall visitor arrivals from Europe increased by 9% compared to the same period in 2015. An analysis of arrivals by country of residence shows significant increases in visitors from the main European markets. Increases were recorded in visitors from France (17%), UK & Eire (16%), Germany (6%) and Italy (5%). A decrease of (13%) was recorded in visitors from Russia.

Visitors from Africa decreased by 6% in 2016 compared to the same period in 2015. A decrease of 9% was recorded in the number of visitors from South Africa.

Asia recorded an 22% increase in visitor arrivals. United Arab Emirates and China recorded increases of 24% and 3% respectively.

Visitors from Oceania decreased by 4% whereas from America, an increase of 6% was recorded in visitors compared to the same period of 2015.

### VISITOR ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT (TABLE 2)

#### Year to date

The number of holidaymakers visiting Seychelles in 2016 was 11% above the 2015 level. The number of visitors on business or combining business with a holiday decreased by 6% below the 2015 level and the number in transit<sup>1</sup> was 10% below the 2015 level.

### ARRIVALS BY TYPE OF CARRIER AND CATEGORY OF PASSENGER (TABLE 3)

In Week 36, visitors made up 79%, residents 20% and seamen 2% of total passengers arriving and 100% of total arrivals were on scheduled flights.

## 3. CONCEPTS SOURCES AND METHODS

For statistical purposes, the term “international visitor” describes “any person who travels to a country other than that in which s/he has his/her usual residence but outside his/her usual environment for a period not exceeding 12 months and whose main purpose of visit is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the country visited.”

<sup>1</sup> Note that transit passengers who do not go through immigration but connect directly on the next outbound flight are not included in the figures for transit.
