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MERCHANDISE TRADE

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The total imports for quarter 3 of 2016 was valued SR3,478.1 million, an increase of 21.1% compared to the corresponding period in 2015. The value of Domestic Exports increased by 28.9% and Re-exports decreased by 2.1% compared to the same period of 2015.

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1. INTRODUCTION

This issue of Quarterly Merchandise Trade Statistics highlights key indicators for Quarter 3 of 2016.

The Classification used follows the guidelines of United Nations International Merchandise Trade Statistics, Concepts and Definitions 2010. Goods are classified under Harmonized System (HS 2007).

Imports are valued C.I.F (Cost, Insurance and Freight) while Exports and Re - Exports are valued F.O.B. (Free on board) which excludes international freight charges and insurance costs.

The trading partner in the case of imports is the country of origin while in the case of exports it is the country of final destination.

2. RESULTS AND HIGHLIGHTS

2016 Q3 (Tables 1a and 1b)

The total imports for the third quarter of 2016 were valued at SR3478.1 million, an increase of 21.1% compared to the same period of 2015. Comparing the figure for 2016 to that of 2015, the total value of Domestic Exports increased from SR757.0 million to SR975.8 million reflecting an increase of 28.9%. A decrease of 2.1% was recorded in the value of Re-exports, from SR556.3 million in 2015 to SR544.4 million in 2016.

The net effect was a trade deficit valued at SR1957.9 million or an increase of 25.5% compared to same period in 2015.

Imports (Tables 2a and 2b)

During the first nine months of 2016 imports increased in monetary value by SR393.9 million reflecting an increase of 4% compared to same period in 2015.

Value of imports by major sections, January - September 2016/2015

During the first nine months of 2016, Food and Live Animals accounted for 27% of imports valued at SR2769.3 million. This was 21% more than in 2015. It must be noted that these imports also include frozen tuna imported for processing by the tuna cannery. Imports of fish and crustaceans accounted for 50% of imports in this category. Imports of Cereals and Cereal Preparations and Meat and Meat Preparations accounted for 8% and 15% respectively.

Imports of Beverages and Tobacco accounted for 3% of the total import bill in 2016. Of this, imports of Tobacco and Tobacco Manufactures decreased by 33% and the imports of Beverages increased by 42% compared to 2015.

Imports of Mineral Fuels were valued at SR1620.3 million and this was 10% lower than in 2015.

Imports of Chemicals for 2016 were valued at SR562.6 million and this was 8% lower than in 2015. Of this value, SR222.6 million represents the imports of Medical and Pharmaceutical products, which was 12% lower than in 2015.

Manufactured Goods accounted for 20% of the total import bill in 2016. This represented an increase of 6% compared to 2015. Of the manufactured goods, 29% were Manufactures of Metals, 22% were Non-metallic Mineral Manufactures, 2%

Textile Fabrics, 27% Articles of Apparel and Clothing Accessories and 21% Wood Manufactures. The import of Textile Manufactures was 52% lower than in 2015. The import of Manufactures of Metal was 1% lower, and Wood Manufactures were 12% higher than in 2015.

Imports of Machinery and Transport accounted for 29% of the total import bill for 2016 and this was 3% lower than in 2015. The imports of road vehicles accounted for SR668.1 million, an increase of 84% compared to 2015.

Domestic Exports (Table 4)

During the first nine month of 2016, domestic exports attained a value of SR2880.4 million. This was 13.8% higher than in 2015. The value of exports of canned tuna increased by 13.7% from SR2343.7 million in 2015 to SR2664.0 million in 2016. The exports of fresh and frozen fish increased by 168.4% compared to 2015. Exports of fish meal were valued at SR76.8 million in 2016 representing a decrease of 3.4%. Exports of sea cucumber were valued at SR34.3 million representing an increase of 19.3% compared to 2015.

Re-exports (Table 5)

During the first nine months of 2016, the value of re-exports stood at SR1678.0 million, representing an increase of 6.1% compared to 2015. Of this, SR1198.7 million, were re-exports of petroleum products to ships and aircraft. Other re-exports were valued at SR479.3 million, representing an increase of 169.0% compared to 2015.

Trade with Selected Economic Communities (Table 6)

Table 6 highlights trade with key Economic Communities of interest. The European Union (EU) tops the list followed by Southern African Development Community (SADC), Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN), Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa (COMESA) and Indian Ocean Commission (IOC). Of importance is Seychelles registered a positive Balance of Trade with several EU member states during 2016.

4. CONCEPTS, SOURCES AND METHODS

Merchandise Trade Statistics compilation follows the General Trade System. The general trade system is in use when the statistical territory coincides with the economic territory.

General Imports consists of:

- (a) Imports of foreign goods (including compensating products after outward processing which changed their origin from domestic to foreign) entering the free circulation area, premises for inward processing, industrial free zones, premises for customs warehousing or commercial free zones;
- (b) Reimports of domestic goods into free circulation area, premises for inward processing or industrial free zones, premises for customs warehousing or commercial free zones.

Reimports are imports of domestic goods which were previously recorded as exports.

General exports consist of:

- (a) Exports of domestic goods (including compensating products after inward processing which changed their origin from foreign to domestic) from any part of the statistical territory, including free zones and customs warehouses;
- (b) Re-exports of foreign goods from any part of the statistical territory, including free zones and customs warehouses.

Re-exports are exports of foreign goods which were previously recorded as imports.

DATA SOURCES

The bulk of the data comes from Customs records, but the NBS also uses non-customs data from selected producers to complement administrative source data and ensure complete coverage.

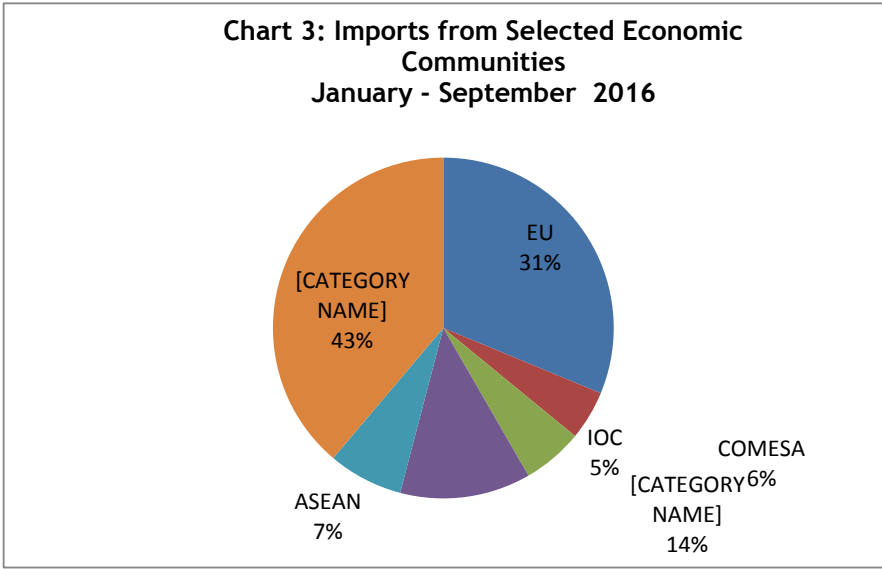
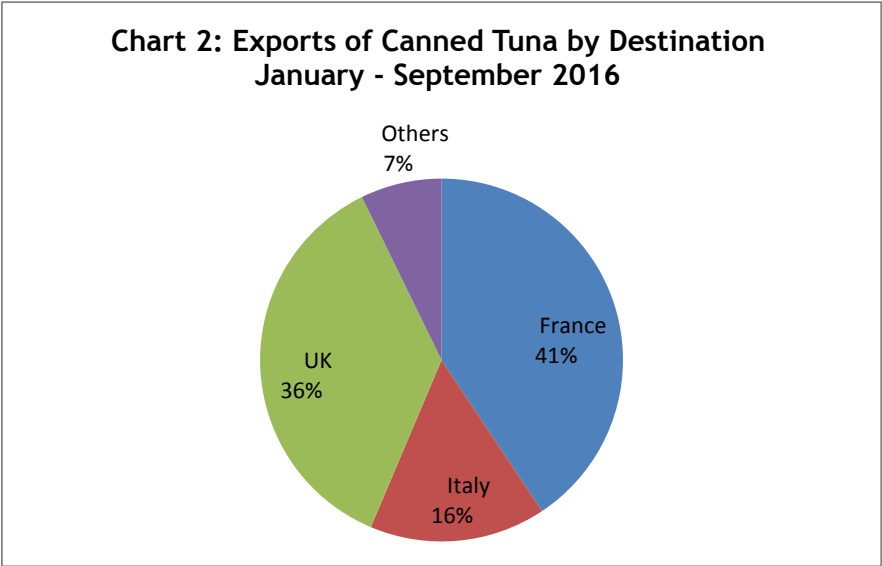
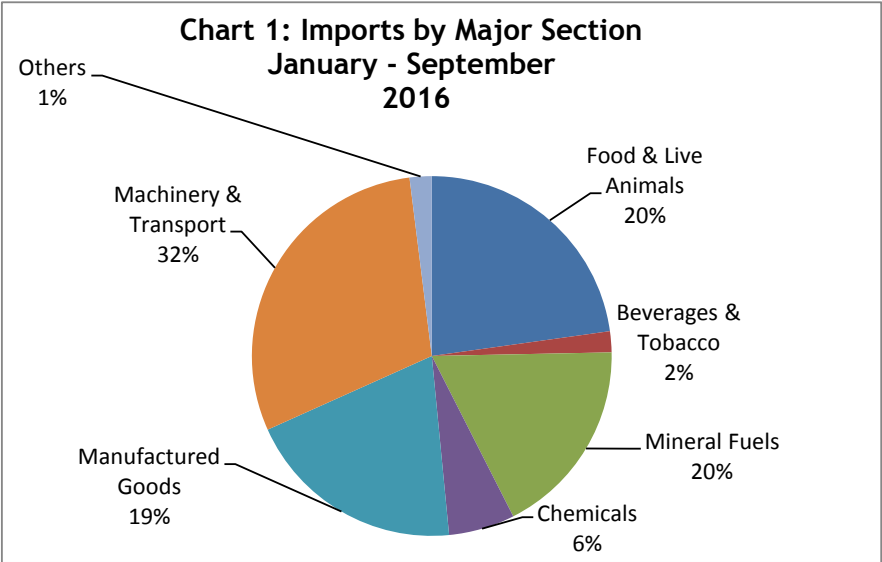
